In *Trade Unionists against Terror*, she explores how workers made sense of their struggle for rights in the face of death squads and other forms of violent opposition from the state. Levenson-Estrada focuses especially on the case of 400 workers at the Coca-Cola bottling plant in Guatemala City, who, in order to protect their union, successfully occupied the factory for over a year beginning in 1984 while the country was under a state of siege. According to Levenson-Estrada, religion provided the language of resistance, and workers who were engaged in what seemed to be a deadend battle constructed an identity for themselves as powerful agents of change. Based on oral histories as well as documentary sources, *Trade Unionists against Terror* also illuminates complex relationships between urban popular culture, gender, family, and workplace activism in Guatemala.
